
- 25 Pray for those who are apprehensive about having to travel quite a distance to get their Covid injection.
- 26 Remember those you know who are still working in countries which have little or no access yet to Covid vaccines and are unable or unwilling to return home.
- 27 Pray for wisdom and guidance for governments and companies throughout the world as they try to prioritise how very large sums of money should be spent.
- 28 Pray for the congregations in Traprain Parish and in Stenton at a difficult time without their own minister. Remember Neil as he seeks to help them as Interim Moderator.
- 29 Pray for, telephone and encourage someone who has not managed to leave their home for months and is feeling very isolated and discouraged.
- 30 Remember people you know who are not able to go back to school yet and are missing their relatives and friends who have.
- 31 Pray for all the older people who are frightened and threatened by e-mails telling them that large sums of money have been taken from their bank account or that their telephone is going to be cut off.

- 13 Tomorrow is Mothering Sunday. Pray for all who have found it impossible to become a mum and will find tomorrow a difficult day.
